**Polyethylene Barrier Wall Construction**

**Award:**

Award will be made per group to the bidder(s) meeting all specifications and offering the lowest overall pricing for the individual group. The entire group must be bid by the bidder. Group 1 (North Region) includes the following Counties: Lauderdale, Colbert, Franklin, Limestone, Lawrence, Madison, Morgan, Cullman, Jackson, Marshall, Dekalb, Etowah, and Cherokee. Group 2 (West Central Region) includes the following Counties: Marion, Winston, Lamar, Fayette, Walker, Pickens, Tuscaloosa, Sumter, Greene, Hale, Bibb, Perry, Dallas, and Chilton. Group 3 (East Central Region) includes the following Counties: Blount, Jefferson, St. Clair, Shelby, Calhoun, Cleburne, Talladega, Clay, Randolph, Coosa, Tallapoosa, and Chambers. Group 4 (Southwest Region) includes the following Counties: Choctaw, Marengo, Wilcox, Washington, Clarke, Monroe, Mobile, Baldwin, Escambia, and Conecuh. Group 5 (Southeast Region) includes the following Counties: Autauga, Elmore, Lee, Lowndes, Montgomery, Macon, Russell, Bullock, Butler, Crenshaw, Pike, Barbour, Covington, Coffee, Dale, Henry, Geneva, and Houston.

**Requirements :**

This solicitation is to award a state wide agreement for all materials, equipment, and labor necessary to complete projects to stop bank erosion at various locations throughout the state of Alabama.

Installation locations and quantities will be furnished to the Vendor through a Purchase Order.

For each project, the vendor will be responsible for providing any/all line items as directed by the ALDOT.

Vendor must have an active general contractor's license in the State of Alabama.

**Pay Item Descriptions:**

**Mobilization:** Descriptions in line items for bag deployment mobilization, heavy equipment mobilization, routine mobilization, and emergency mobilization. Bag deployment mobilization includes equipment for bag installation. Heavy equipment mobilization includes trackhoe and backhoe mobilization. Routine Mobilization is 30 days response time. Emergency Mobilization is 5 days response time.

**Bags:** All sizes of the barriers will have a 2' opening at the top that is centered on the base of the barrier. The base of the barrier will be 2' wider than the height of the barrier. The barrier will be baffled every 2'. The barrier will be made of 8 oz. polypropylene. The barrier will be waterproof or plastic coated. The barrier will be capable of being put together in order to make a continuous barrier. The barrier must be of sufficient strength to maintain the needed amount of material ( concrete, gravel, sand, stone, or millings). Minimum quantity of bag length is 50' and additional lengths will be in 50' increments.

- 2 feet tall with a 2 foot wide opening at the top ( top is a total of 2 feet wide and with a 4 foot wide base)
- 3 feet tall with a 2 foot wide opening at the top (top is a total of 2 feet wide and with a 5 foot wide base)
- 4 feet tall with a 2 foot wide opening at the top (top is a total of 2 feet wide and with a 6 foot wide base)
- 6 feet tall with a 2 foot wide opening at the top (top is a total of 2 feet wide and with a 8 foot wide base)

**Reusable Barrier:** Reusable barriers can be used multiple times and will become the property of ALDOT after the initial use. All sizes of the reusable barrier will have a 2' wide opening at the top. The base of the reusable barrier will be 2' wider than its height. Reusable barrier will be baffled every 2'. The reusable barriers will be made of 8 oz. polypropylene. The reusable barriers will be plastic coated or waterproof. The reusable barrier will have a separable bottom section and top section. The two sections, top and bottom, will be put together to make a continuous reusable barrier. Minimum quantity of bag length is 50' and additional lengths will be in 50' increments. Fill material may be provided by ALDOT, if available, as directed by ALDOT Engineer.

**Installation Equipment:** Includes all equipment and labor needed to install/hold bag before and during filling with material.

**Labor:** Include all labor costs required for delivering the bags to the site, filling, and installing the bags. May be prevailing wage or non-prevailing wage labor, line items for each.

**On-Site Tech Support:** Provide on-site technical support covering all aspect of installation.

**Concrete Pump Truck:** Hours for actual use, doesn't include down time or travel time.

**Small Deflection Barriers:** 27" base, 3' long barrier has 3 cells, each cell at the top has a 12" by 12" opening. Each barrier has a male and female end for joining together. Strap webbing and D-rings will be used to attach each barrier together. Lifting loops attached to the barrier at each end. Attached lid with 3 straps and D-rings used for full containment. Material is 8.5 oz. polypropylene

**Large Deflection Barriers:** 36" base, 4' long barrier has 4 cells, each cell at the top has an 18" by 18" opening. Each barrier has a male and female end for joining together. Strap webbing and D-rings will be used to attach each barrier together. Lifting loops attached to the barrier at each end. Attached lid with 3 straps and D-rings used for full containment. Material is 8.5 oz. polypropylene

**6" Minus Stone:** All aggregate must pass thru a six inch opening. An alternative to aggregate is clean compacted sand for back fill.

**Concrete Placing Boom:** The boom must have a 52' reach and must be self-propelled, so it can maneuver around job site.

**6" Water Pump:** Minimum 6" discharge.

**Light Plants:** A light tower with a minimum of 4 light bulbs with a diesel engine.

**Traffic Control:** Provide traffic control for interstate, primary and secondary routes as dictated by the latest approved edition of ALDOT Standard Drawings or MUTCD.

**Delivery:** All shipments shall be F.O.B. Destination to the receiving agency. The vendor shall be fully responsible for all shipments and freight charges. The responsibility for filing freight claims lies with the vendor.

**Mobilization:** All work listed on a single order is to be completed during a single mobilization, and each work order will result in a single mobilization payment.

The Contractor shall provide work zone traffic control (including devices, placement, equipment/ vehicle requirements, and worker requirements) in accordance with the latest editions of the following documents:

All work zone traffic control devices shall be appropriate/proper for the given work zone and shall be in place before work commences each business day. The Engineer shall direct to Contractor to suspend operations at any time Work Zone Traffic Control is not compliant. The Contractor shall take immediate action to correct the deficiency(-ies). No work shall proceed until the deficiency(-ies) is/are corrected. All Work Zone Traffic Control devices shall be promptly removed when work is complete each day.

All Traffic Control Plans must be approved by the Engineer in charge prior to beginning work.



## **Specific Terms and Conditions**

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this TITB (Transportation Invitation to Bid) is to establish a statewide Erosion Control (MA) using Polyethylene Barrier Wall Construction. This MA will only be used by the Alabama Department of Transportation, through the Model Procurement Act.

### **Award:**

Award will be made per group to the bidder(s) meeting all specifications and offering the lowest overall pricing for the individual group. The entire group must be bid by the bidder. **Group 1** (North Region) includes the following Counties: Lauderdale, Colbert, Franklin, Limestone, Lawrence, Madison, Morgan, Cullman, Jackson, Marshall, Dekalb, Etowah, and Cherokee. **Group 2** (West Central Region) includes the following Counties: Marion, Winston, Lamar, Fayette, Walker, Pickens, Tuscaloosa, Sumter, Greene, Hale, Bibb, Perry, Dallas, and Chilton. **Group 3** (East Central Region) includes the following Counties: Blount, Jefferson, St. Clair, Shelby, Calhoun, Cleburne, Talladega, Clay, Randolph, Coosa, Tallapoosa, and Chambers. **Group 4** (Southwest Region) includes the following Counties: Choctaw, Marengo, Wilcox, Washington, Clarke, Monroe, Mobile, Baldwin, Escambia, and Conecuh. **Group 5** (Southeast Region) includes the following Counties: Autauga, Elmore, Lee, Lowndes, Montgomery, Macon, Russell, Bullock, Butler, Crenshaw, Pike, Barbour, Covington, Coffee, Dale, Henry, Geneva, and Houston.

### **Bid submission instructions:**

### **Delivery time frame:**

All items ordered must be delivered to the "ship to" address shown on the P.O. within thirty (90) days of vendor's receipt of order, unless previously agreed upon in writing by the ordering agency.

### **Unrealistic Pricing:**

Percentage discounts that are found to be unrealistic may be rejected.

### **Contract period:**

Establish a 12-month contract with an option to extend for a second, third, fourth, and fifth 12-month period with the same pricing, terms and conditions. The second, third, fourth, or fifth 12-month period, if agreed by both parties, would begin the day after the first, second, third, or fourth 12-month period expires. Any successive extension must have written approval of both the state and vendor no later than 30 days prior to expiration of the previous 12-month period.

### **Price Escalation:**

If, during the performance of this contract, the price of the material or cost of the labor involved significantly increases through no fault of the supplier, a price increase may be considered. Documentation of a price increase for materials is required from the manufacturer. Documentation of a price increase for labor is required from the supplier. Any proposed increases in labor and/or materials may not exceed increases in CPI (Consumer Price Index) for the same time period. All price increases must be approved by both the state and the supplier in writing. Any de-escalation in price shall be passed onto the state immediately while still meeting all specifications, terms, and conditions of the contract.

**Indemnity:** Contractor shall be fully liable for the actions of its agents, employees, officers, partners, and Subcontractors, and shall fully indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Division, Eligible Users, and the State of Alabama from all claims, losses, suits, actions, damages, and costs of every name and description arising out of Contractor's performance of this Contract caused by any intentional act or negligence of Contractor, its agents, employees, officers, partners, or Subcontractors, without limitation; provided, however, that the Contractor shall not indemnify for that portion of any claim, loss, or damage

arising hereunder due to the sole fault of the Division, Eligible Users, or the State of Alabama. The parties agree that if there are any limitations of the Contractor's liability, including a limitation of liability clause for anyone for whom the Contractor is responsible, such limitations of liability will not apply to injuries to persons, including death, or to damages to property.

**Non-appropriation of funds:**

Continuation of any agreement between the State and a bidder beyond a fiscal year is contingent upon continued legislative appropriation of funds for the purpose of this bid and any resulting agreement. Non-availability of funds at any time shall cause any agreement to become void and unenforceable and no liquidated damages shall accrue to the state as a result. The State will not incur liability beyond the payment of accrued agreement payment.

**Proration:**

Any provision of a contract resulting from this bid to the contrary notwithstanding, in the event of failure of the State to make payment hereunder as a result of partial unavailability, at the time such payment is due, of such sufficient revenues of the State to make such payment (proration of appropriated funds for the State having been declared by the governor pursuant to Section 41-4-90 of the Code of Alabama 1975), the contractor shall have the option, in addition to the other remedies of the contract, of renegotiating the contract (extending or changing payment terms or amounts) or terminating the contract.

**Quantity:**

The exact quantity of each item is unknown. The Department of Transportation does not guarantee the State will buy any amount. Orders will be placed by the agency as needed and they will be given complete shipping instructions.

**Quote Requirement:**

All quotes shall include an estimate per job with the job location with the Area & District the job is located in..

**Volume Discounts:**

Volume Discounts are allowed with the provision that any purchasing entity that purchases the equivalent volume be offered the same discount. The State will not file for rebates; the vendor must offer and bill the net discounted price for any applicable offerings.

**Requested information:**

Any additional information requested from a vendor must be furnished within five (5) days from receipt of request.
