To Whom It May Concern:

Please see below our current Interstate/Highway restrictions for permitted travel due to construction and other hazardous conditions.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY regardless of any permits, routing authorizations, etc. you may have in your possession: It is unlawful for **vehicles or combination of vehicles and loads wider than twelve feet** to travel on the following sections of highways:

- US Route 84 - from the intersection of US 31 (East of Evergreen, AL) to the intersection of AL Route 55 (Andalusia, AL) and vice versa in Conecuh and Covington County
- US Route 82 – from the intersection of AL 14 (Prattville, AL) to the intersection of AL 25 (Centreville, AL) and vice versa in Autauga, Chilton, and Bibb County
- AL Route 110 – from the intersection of CR 83 to the intersection of US82 (Union Springs, AL) and vice versa in Montgomery and Bullock County

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY regardless of any permits, routing authorizations, etc. you may have in your possession: It is unlawful for **any oversize/overweight vehicle or combination of vehicles (no permitted travel)** to travel on the following sections of highways:

- Interstate Route 10 - from Exit 26B (Water Street) to Exit 27 (US Route 90), the George Wallace Tunnel, and vice versa in Mobile County
- US Route 98 - from the intersection of South Conception Street to the intersection of US Route 90 (Bankhead Tunnel) and vice versa in Mobile County
- US Route 72/43 – from the intersection of AL 184 (Muscle Shoals, AL) to the intersection of AL 157 (Florence, AL) and vice versa in Lauderdale and Colbert County
- AL Route 22 - from the intersection of US Route 31 (Near Verbena, AL) to the intersection of US Route 231 (Rockford, AL) and vice versa in Chilton and Coosa Counties
- AL Route 101 – Wheeler Dam Bridge in Lauderdale and Colbert County


- US Route 331 – Lightwood Knot Creek Bridge in Covington County
- AL Route 281 - from the intersection of Cheaha Rd. (Entrance to Cheaha State Park) to the intersection of US Route 431 and vice versa in Clay and Cleburne County
- Natchez Trace Parkway - from the Mississippi State Line to the Tennessee State Line and vice versa in Cherokee and Lauderdale County
- AL Route 25 - from the intersection of US 31 (Calera, AL) to the intersection of AL 70 (Columbiana, AL) and vice versa in Shelby County
- AL Route 117 – from the intersection of US 72 to the intersection of CR 91 (Captain John Snodgrass Bridge) in Jackson County
- AL Route 36 – from the intersection of I-65 to the intersection of AL 67 and vice versa in Morgan County
- AL Route 168 – from the intersection of CR 26 to the intersection of AL 68 and vice versa in Marshall County
- AL Route 211 – from the intersection of I-59 to the intersection of US 431 (Gadsden, AL) and vice versa in Etowah County
- AL Route 34 – from the intersection of AL 77 to the intersection of CR 366 (Talladega, AL) and vice versa in Talladega County

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY regardless of any permits, routing authorizations, etc. you may have in your possession: It is unlawful for **any overweight vehicles or combination of vehicles** to travel on the following sections of highways:

- AL Route 20 – from the intersection of AL 67 to the intersection of US 31 (Decatur, AL) and vice versa in Morgan County
- US Route 43 – from the intersection of AL 18 (Berry, AL) to the intersection of Rose Blvd. (Northport, AL) and vice versa in Fayette and Tuscaloosa County

If you need single trip permits, have annual permits or long-term routings, you may contact this office for alternative routing. This office has had numerous complaints about over-dimensional loads entering construction zones, thereby putting at risk employees of this department, contractor's personnel, and the general public as well as destroying traffic control devices in these areas. The Department of Transportation will not tolerate these actions. Please be advised that movement of over-dimensional vehicles larger than those specified in this letter through the above-mentioned areas is unlawful. This Department may refuse to issue, or may cancel, suspend, or revoke the permitting privileges of an applicant or permittee who is observed in these sections of the highways.
