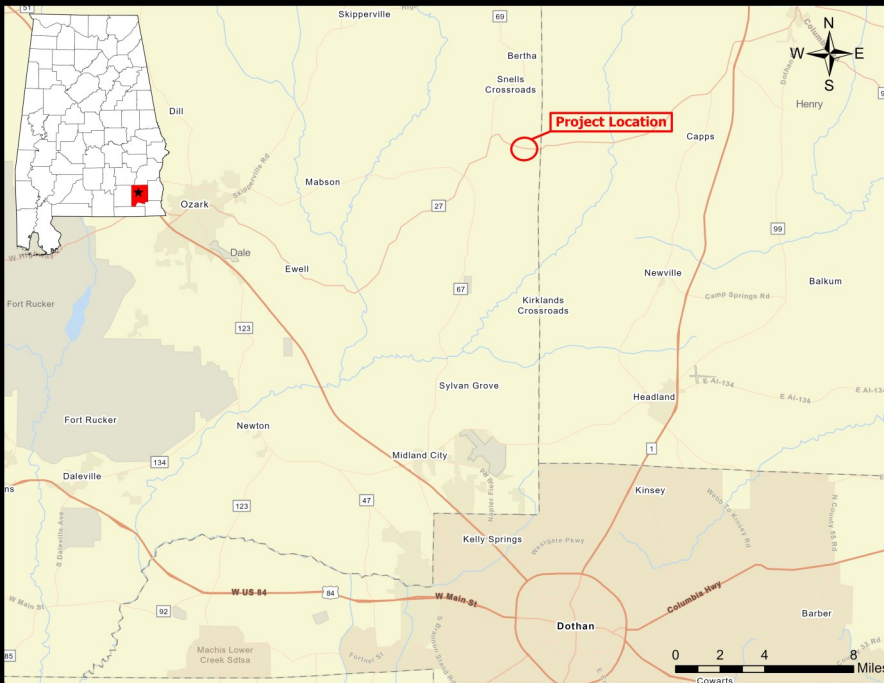


Online and In-Person Public Involvement

Bridge Replacement on AL-27 over Deal Creek

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing to replace the bridge over Deal Creek on AL-27 20 miles north of Dothan in Dale County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by mail, email, or voicemail described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by August 19, 2022.



Project Description

- ◆ Replacement of the bridge on AL-27 over Deal Creek with a bridge culvert
- ◆ Detour will be provided from Ozark AL-105 through Skipperville to AL-10 in Abbeville, Alabama.
- ◆ The proposed project is approximately a quarter mile in length.
