


## Online and In-Person Public Involvement

Intersection Improvements at US-82 and US-231

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing improvements to the intersection of AL-53 (US-82) and AL-6 (US-231) in Montgomery County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by December 22, 2022.



## **Project Description**

The proposed project will modify the intersection at US-231 and US-82. The proposed work includes:

- Adding a signal at the intersection of US-231 and US-82.
- Median alterations along SR-53.
- Adding a right turn lane on SR-6 to Old Carter Hill Road.
