

Project Description

- Project begins at 1st Avenue in Hartford and ends at East Cox Street in Slocomb.
- Majority of the widening of the roadway will occur between County Road 69/Shiloh Road in Hartford to North Rex Street in Slocomb.
- Project will widen the roadway to five (5) lanes with two-lanes in each direction and a center two-way lane.
 - Additional Right of way will be required for project construction
