## **Project Description**

The proposed project involves resurfacing, curb and gutter, traffic control markings, 6-ft sidewalk, ADA curb ramps, brick pavers, lighting, drainage improvements, and additional streetscape improvements on Main Avenue from 5th Street to SR-6 (US-82). A roundabout will be installed at 10th Street to alleviate congestion at this location. A small park area will be added within the right-of-way between 10th Street and Park Street to provide a social gathering space with outdoor seating. The project aims to improve the city's infrastructure, while providing pedestrian connectivity to the downtown district.
