Project Description

ALDOT is proposing the replacement of two sets of roadway/ pedestrian bridges on SR-1 (US-431) over Chewalla Creek and an abandoned Georgia Southwestern Railroad line. These bridges will be replaced with wider bridges to accommodate high roadway traffic volumes. The new bridges will also be equipped with pedestrian sidewalks in order to continue to accommodate foot traffic along the corridor.
