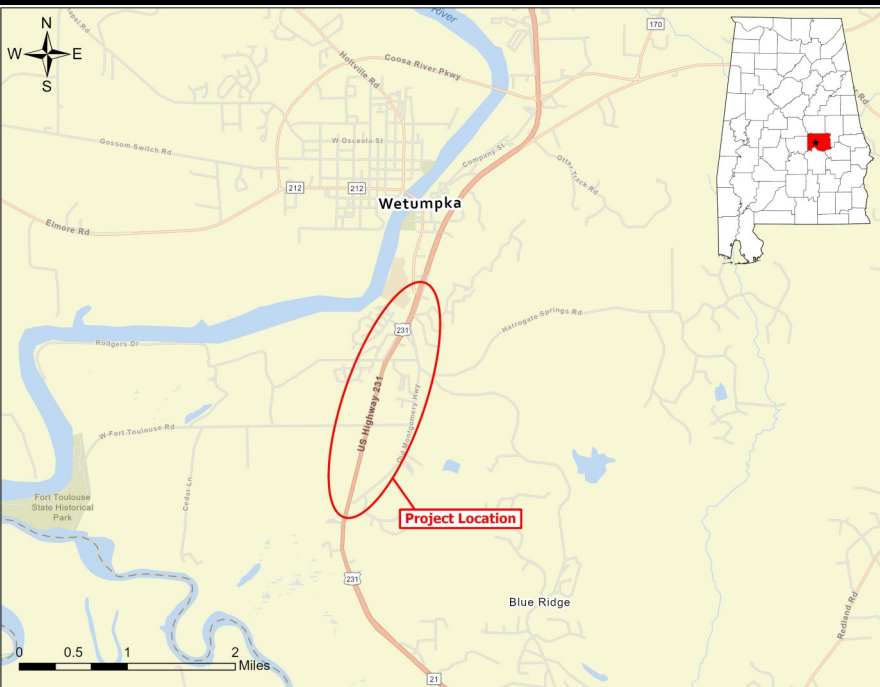

Access Management on AL-9(US-231) in Wetumpka

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing improvements to US-231 in Wetumpka in Elmore County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **January 23, 2023**.



Project Description

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve traffic flow and address safety concerns on this section of roadway in Wetumpka. The proposed work includes:

- Adding concrete islands in the median to restrict unsafe turning movements
- Addition of U-turn lanes to provide access to the opposite side of the roadway
- Removal of redundant driveways
