


Online and In-Person Public Involvement

Project Description

The purpose of the proposed project is to improve traffic flow and address safety concerns on this section of roadway in Troy. The proposed work includes:

- Adding concrete islands in the median to restrict unsafe turning movements.
- Addition of U-turns lanes to provide access to the opposite of the roadway.
