Emergency Stop Truck Ramp on AL-35

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing the addition of an emergency stop truck ramp on AL-35 in Fort Payne, Dekalb County, Alabama. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **April 28, 2023**.



Project Description

- The proposed project is located on AL-35, coming down the mountain into Fort Payne, Alabama.
- The ramp will utilize pea gravel to facilitate the slowing down of the trucks in emergency situations.
- The sidewalk will be moved to the west side of the truck ramp to maintain bicycle and pedestrian access.
- Right of way will be required for the proposed project.
