


Online and In-Person Public Involvement

Improvements at AL-6 (US-82, McFarland Blvd) and AL-13 (US-43)

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing improvements to the intersection of AL-6 (US-82, McFarland Blvd) and AL-13 (US-43) in Northport, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by October 28, 2023.



Project Description

The purpose of this project is to relieve traffic congestion at the intersection of US-82 and US-43 during the morning and afternoon peak hours.

This project will add additional turn lanes at the signalized intersection of US-82 and US-43 as well as an additional thru-lane on US-43 Northbound. Access management in the area of the intersection will also be included.
