

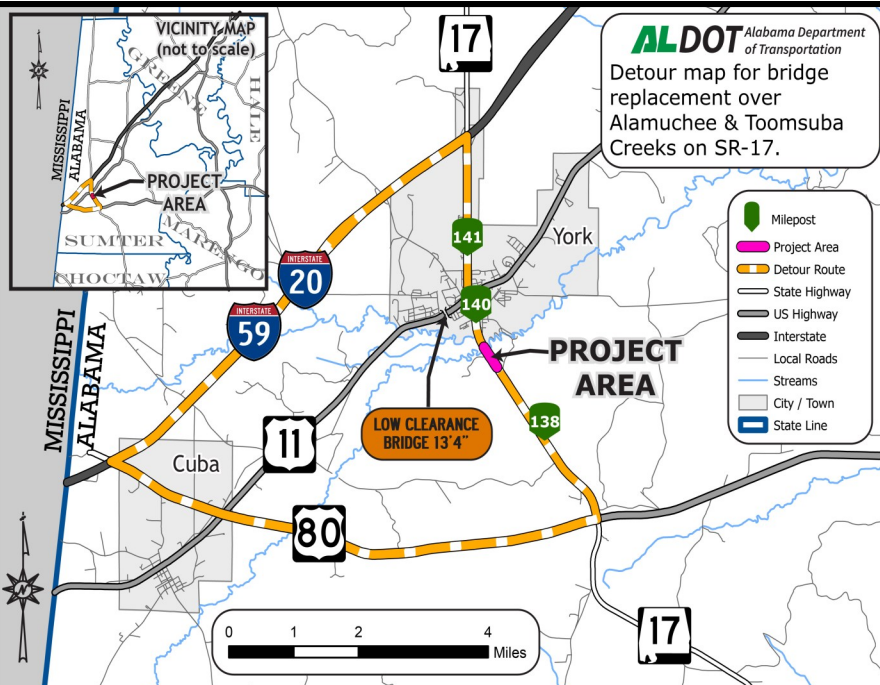

Bridge Replacement on AL-17 Over Alamuchee Creek and Toomsuba Creek

The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) is proposing replacement of the existing bridges on AL-17 over Alamuchee Creek and Toomsuba Creek in Sumter County. Information about the project is available to the public for review and comment. Your comments may be provided by US mail, email, voicemail, or online as described below. Comments for the proposed project must be submitted by **August 8, 2026**.



Project Description

The purpose of this project is to address aging infrastructure and functional deficiencies of the existing bridges. The bridges were constructed in 1938 and do not meet modern design standards due to the narrow width of the existing bridges.

The new bridges will provide for 12-ft travel lanes and 8-ft shoulders.

The construction of these bridges will require an off-site detour around the project. A recommended detour will be signed to include AL-8 (US-80) and I-59/I-20.
