Warning Notices for Disqualification and Default

Should the need arise that a warning notice per Subarticle 108.04(e) Unsatisfactory Progress or Article 108.12 Default of Contract is necessary, please be advised that those letters shall only be sent from the Construction Bureau. The Area will review the pertinent information and records from the Project Manager, and then forward a recommendation to the Construction Bureau for further handling. From there, the Bureau will proceed with warning notices as needed, responses from the Contractor, follow-ups with the Area, and further action, if required.

Normally, these type notices are infrequent, and follow-up action is rare. However, when action is required, the Bureau coordinates that action with Office Engineer due to the impact on bidding, sublet approvals, DBE utilization, and takeover agreements.

Please ensure that your Area contract administration personnel, project managers, consultants, and county engineers are familiar with this CIM.
