PG 76-22

Effective July 10, 2002 Ergon, Inc. is allowed a maximum allowable shipping temperature of 380°F (193°C) for PG 76-22 as per the recommendations of Ergons published procedure for handling, storage and mixing. This increase in shipping temperature has been shown not to be damaging to Ergons PG 76-22. This does not affect Ergon, Inc.'s PG 67-22, PG 64-22P, PG 58-22 or Emulsions and Cutback shipping temperatures.
